

Marathon is an independent energy services company that sells natural gas/electricity in parts of New York. Marathon does not represent the distribution utility. Under deregulation, customers like you have the right to purchase energy supply from an independent ESCO like Marathon instead of being tied to the distribution utility.

You now have the opportunity to purchase natural gas/electricity supply directly from Marathon.

- The term will be Fixed and the rate will NOT change during the life of the agreement.
- There are no enrollment fees for taking service from Marathon.
- Marathon Power LLC does not offer Utility Price Matching or guarantee savings.
- After the initial term, unless otherwise agreed to, agreement shall renew into a variable rate.
- The utility will continue to deliver the supply purchased from Marathon, issue a consolidated bill and respond to leaks and emergencies---just like they do now.
- There will be no reduction in the quality and safety of commodity service.
- On your utility Delivery Services, you can benefit from depending on your location, a reduction in the applicable sales tax.
- You cannot terminate your agreement early, if you do so, you will be subject to cancelation fees. The cancelation fee is the projected amount of natural gas and/or electricity to be consumed by you for the remainder of the current Term multiplied by the difference between the Fixed price in effect for the remainder of the current Term and the price at which Marathon can sell such gas and/or electricity following the termination.
- For all residential customers and commercial customers solicited through door-to-door marketing, the Administrative Fee will be no greater than \$100 if the remaining term is less than 12 months and \$200 if the remaining term is 12 months or more.
- Once account has been enrolled and the Utility has identified a different service class, Marathon reserves the right to adjust the account according to utility rate classification at current corresponding price plan.
